Eligibility Requirements;	01
1. Ownership within the same family for 10	$00$ or more years by July 4, $19\frac{93}{}$ of at least $40$ acres of Iowa farmland

2. Present owner must be related to a person who owned the land at least 100 years ago.

3. Application must be notarized and submitted by June 1, 19 93.

• One Century farm marker per farm will be furnished by Iowa Farm Bureau. Additional markers may be purchased upon request.

One Century Farm Certificate will be awarded for each legal farm owner by Iowa Department of Agriculture

and Land Stewardship. Additional certificates may be purchased.
